1. None appears on behalf of the petitioner at the time of call.

2. The matter relates to payment of compensation on account of tiger attack.

3. Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent no.6 fairly submits that an order was passed by the Court on 11th July, 2019 in the earlier writ petition filed by the petitioner being W.P. 12055 (W) of 2019 directing the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas to hear the parties and pass a reasoned order.

4. Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the District Magistrate has placed before this Court, copy of the order dated 20th August, 2019 passed in compliance of the order passed by the Court. However, there is no proof of service of the aforesaid order on the writ petitioner.

8. The instruction by the Deputy Field Director, Sundarban Tiger Reserve dated 29th April, 2024 is also taken on record.

9. The writ petition stands disposed of.
