Learned advocate for the petitioner

is aggrieved as no steps have been taken
by the police authorities.

However, learned advocate for the
State has submitted a report which reflects
that number of cases has been registered.
But, so far as the information which was
furnished by the present petitioner is
concerned, a specific case being Jibantala
PS Case No. 244 of 2025 dated
01.05.2025 was registered for investigation
against the private respondent nos. 5 to
10 for allegedly forcefully trespassing into

the house of the petitioner and assaulting upon her son-in-law as also threatening her to damage her house and for withdrawing the case.

Learned advocate for the private respondents disputes and denies such contention and submits that a normal dispute has been converted into a criminal case.

Be that as it may, since the police authorities have registered a criminal case, they would take the investigation of the case to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 8983 of 2025 is disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
