In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Baishnabnagar Police Station Case No. 590 of 2024 dated 26.06.2024 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

And

In Re : **Jahangir Alam and others**

... Petitioners.

Mr. Anand Keshari

... For the State.

Let the bail application be de-tagged.

It has been pointed out that the subject-matter of the present case involves recovery of 400 grams of Brown Sugar from the joint possession of the petitioners.

Having considered that the seizure is of commercial quantity of contraband, I am of the opinion that the provision of Section 37 of the NDPS Act is attracted.

Accordingly, the application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 490 of 2025, is dismissed.

However, the State would take steps for expediting the progress of the trial.
