Be that as it may, since the petitioner is a lady, she cannot be deprived of her shelter. Accordingly, Superintendent of Police, Basirhat Police District will consider the representation dated 04.04.2025 made by the petitioner.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition being WPA 9286 of 2025 is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
