Petitioner has approached this Court being
aggrieved by the outcome of the investigation relating to
South Bidhannagar P.S. Case No.311 of 2024 dated
December 8, 2024. Petitioner has already preferred an
application under Section 173(8) of Cr.P.C..

The main grievance of the petitioner is with
regard to complicity of the officers of the Kolkata
Municipal Corporation as the Investigating Agency on
conclusion of investigation did not implicate them in the

pending.

circumstances, try to conclude the hearing and dispose
