Learned Advocates representing the parties today before this Court by consent and jointly submit that, there has been a typographical error in the order dated **May 22, 2025** and the same may be corrected and modified accordingly.

In view of the above the following corrections are made :

- a) in the appearance part and wherever it appears in the order dated **May 22, 2025** the names of the learned Advocates showing to have appeared for the petitioner stand deleted altogether and in place thereof the names of Mr. Manas Kr. Ghosh, learned Advocate and Ms. Susmita Dey (Basu), learned Advocate shall be incorporated;
- b) in the fourth line of the fifth paragraph on the first page of the order dated May 22, 2025 the expression “Contributory Provident Fund” shall be replaced by “Leave Salary” and the expression “Contributory Provident Fund” stands deleted ;
- and
