This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiffs praying for a direction upon the learned Judge, 13th Bench, City Civil Court at Calcutta to dispose of Miscellaneous Case No.2216 of 2023 expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or their learned advocates appearing before the learned trial judge.
