Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate
for the petitioners be kept with the record.

The husband of the petitioner no. 1 was an
approved Assistant Teacher of a primary school who
died-in-harness on March 06, 2019.

The Pension Payment Order of the employee
concerned was issued on August 05, 2022 in
pursuance whereof the petitioners received the
gratuity and arrear family Pension on September 23,
2022.

The petitioners are praying that a writ of
mandamus be issued commanding the respondents
to pay interest on the said amount of gratuity and
arrear pension for the delayed payment.

Learned advocate for the State-respondents
does not oppose the prayer of the petitioners.

It is now well settled that the petitioners are
entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury
Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay
interest @ 8% per annum on the gratuity and the

arrear amount of family pension from the date of death of the employee concerned till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A. 10850 of 2024 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
