In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023/ Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 in connection with **Bhimpur** P.S. Case No.**401 of 2023** dated **23.10.2023** under Sections **341/323/325/308/304/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Considering the nature of allegations and the materials available in the case diary and the fact that similarly circumstanced co-accused were granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 25.04.2025 in CRM (A) 1318 of 2025, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioners.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioners shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses and shall stay outside the jurisdiction of Bhimpur Police Station for a period of six months from this date, except for attending the jurisdictional Court or meeting the Investigation Officer.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
