This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the applicant in a proceeding being Miscellaneous Succession Case No.23 of 2021 pending before the learned District Delegate, Berhampore praying for expeditious disposal of such proceeding.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or the learned advocates representing the opposite party before the learned trial judge.

After disposal of the interlocutory applications, the learned Judge is requested to make an endeavour to dispose of the Miscellaneous Succession Case No.23 of 2021 as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

There will be no order as to costs.
