1. Report filed on behalf of the State is placed on record.
2. Order dated 7.3.2024 granting anticipatory bail to opposite party nos. 2 to 5 herein has been assailed.
3. Learned judge noted dispute between the parties is civil in nature and civil proceedings are pending *inter se*.
4. Whether the registered deeds are forged or product of threat and coercion may be assessed at the appropriate stage of the proceeding. Allegations of threats are generic and not supported by material evidence.
5. Order impugned is a reasoned one and does not call for interference.
6. Application for cancellation of bail is dismissed.
