The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that no steps have been taken by the police authorities pursuant to the information furnished with Officer-in-charge of the Tamluk Police Station.

State has submitted a report which reflects that on the basis of an representation of one Madan Mohan Rana (the petitioner no.2), Tamluk P.S. Case No. 396 of 2025 dated 19.05.2025 has been registered for investigation.

In view of the investigation having commenced, further pendency of the writ petition is unwarranted. However, the police authorities are directed to take the

investigation to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 10500 of 2025 is disposed of.
