1. Nobody is present on behalf of the appellant.
2. Learned Advocate for the Union of India is present.
3. Learned Advocate for the State is present.
4. In pursuance of the direction passed by this Court dated 16.6.2025 a report is submitted by the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Central Division, Howrah, which is handed over by the learned Advocate for the State during course of hearing,
