In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Karaya P.S. Case No.63 of 2024 dated 09.03.2025 under Sections 498A/406/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, South 24-Parganas at Alipore.

Considering the nature of allegations and the alleged role ascribed to the present petitioner and the fact that charge sheet has already been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner who is purportedly the 75 years old father in law of the alleged victim.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition not to threaten or intimidate witnesses and to attend the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed.

The application for anticipatory bail being **CRM(A) 1608 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
