This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), 2nd Court at Barasat to dispose of the application under Order 7 Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure expeditiously.

Mr. Chakraborty, learned advocate appearing for the opposite party No.4. A copy of the civil revision application has been served upon Mr. Chakraborty in course of this day.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, this Court is of the considered view that there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the other opposite parties.
