It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that trial has already commenced and one witness has been examined. It is also submitted on behalf of the petitioner that a prayer for discharge was made on behalf of the petitioner and the same was rejected.

First, charge sheet was submitted and the trial has begun. Yet, an application has been filed seeking quashing of an FIR. Moreover, no order of rejection of prayer for discharge has been annexed in the revision petition.
