made on or about 24.03.2025 with the Officer-in-Charge
of Rampurhat Police Station. The main grievance of the
petitioner related to a work which was done for which
cheque was issued and the same was subsequently
dishonoured.

Be that as it may, State has submitted a report
which reflects that Rampurhat Police Station case no.
244/2025 dated 19.05.2025 has been registered for
investigation under Sections 420/406 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Having considered that the purpose for which the
writ petition has been preferred being subserved, further
pendency of the writ petition is unwarranted.

Accordingly, WPA 10765 of 2025 is disposed of.
