Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner complains of land dispute relating to demarcation, conversion at the behest of the private respondents.

Learned advocate for the private respondents on the other hand submits that the petitioner and the private respondents are co-sharers in respect of the subject property. State has submitted a report, wherefrom it reflect that number of proceedings have been drawn up and the petitioner and the respondents have made counter complains relating to encroachment of the property.

Be that as it may, if there has been violation of law, petitioner would approach the jurisdictional Statutory Courts for their remedies. Police authorities have drawn up proceedings under Sections 126/135 of the BNSS and they would continue their surveillance and would ensure that there is no breach of the peace and/or tranquility takes place.

With the aforesaid observations WPA 10703 of 2025 is disposed of.
