Report in the form of affidavit affirmed on December 6, 2024 is filed on behalf of the West Bengal Board of Primary Education; let it be kept with the record.

The petitioner had participated in the selection process initiated by the Board in the year 2022 for recruitment of Assistant Teachers in primary schools of the State as a para-teacher and she had appeared before the concerned District Primary School Council for counseling; the petitioner is complaining that till date, the fate of her candidature has not been communicated to her.

The report says that para-teachers of the Primary schools were eligible to participate in the said selection process; the petitioner since was a para-teacher of an upper primary school, which was detected at the time of counseling, is not eligible for appointment; accordingly, her candidature was rejected.

In view of such, WPA 11625 of 2024 fails. There shall however be no order as to costs.
