Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the injury report of the victim which indicated previous delivery/abortion and the statement made by the victim before the doctor about forcible abortion in collusion with a quack doctor, her statement before the Magistrate and the statement of neighbour contained at page 13 of the case diary, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The application for anticipatory bail being **CRM(A) 1671 of 2025** is, thus, rejected.
