1. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. The petitioner claims interest on delayed payment of terminal benefits. The petitioner superannuated from service of the WBTCCL on **January 31, 2024**. He received his provident fund benefits of **Rs. 27,49,323/-** towards provident fund on **February 11, 2025**.
