1. Both the parties to the instant contempt application are represented by their respective learned counsel.
2. At the time of hearing, Mr. Dhar, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the writ petitioners has filed an order dated 18.03.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No.37735-37737/2025, which is taken on record.
