This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff in O.S. No. 42 of 2024 praying for a direction upon the learned Additional District Judge, 2nd Court at Barasat to dispose of the said suit expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to issue notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite parties or upon the learned advocates representing them before the learned trial judge.

In the light of the submissions made by the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner, C.O. 1801 of 2025 is disposed of by requesting the learned learned Additional District Judge, 2nd Court at Barasat to take up the hearing of O.S. 42 of 2024, if the same is otherwise ready for hearing and to make an endeavour to dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.
