1. Considering the materials available in the case diary and the alleged role ascribed to the present petitioners and the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
2. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to further conditions that the petitioners shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses. The petitioners shall attend the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed.
3. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
