Today the writ petition appears under the heading **“To be mentioned”** at the instance of the petitioner for correction of an apparent typographical error of the order dated **June 18, 2025**.

Parties have agreed that there have been typographical mistakes in the second page of the order dated June 18, 2025.

Accordingly, by consent of the appearing parties quantum mentioned erroneously in the second page of the order dated June 18, 2025 are corrected that in the first paragraph of the second page of the order the quantum should be read as **Rs.20,00,000/-** in place and stead of Rs.19,70,231/-.

Identically, in the second paragraph of the second page the quantum should be read and corrected as **Rs.8,00,000/-** in place of Rs.7,70,231/-.
