C.R.M. (A) 1760 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Debra PS Case No.134/2025 dated 18.02.2025, under Sections 126(2)/115(1)/118(1)/76/89/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

The prime allegations in this case are that the petitioners and others physically assaulted the de facto complainant/lady and caused termination of her pregnancy and also sexually assaulted her minor daughter.

Considering the serious nature of allegations and the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the injury report, the bed-head ticket of the de facto complainant and the statements of the de facto complainant and her minor daughter recorded before the learned Magistrate, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 1760 of 2025** is, thus, rejected.
