2. It appears from the record that no affidavit in opposition has been filed from the side of the respondents as yet, in view of the report submitted by the Registry.
3. It is submitted that the writ petitioner has filed this writ petition challenging the inaction of the Madrasa Service Commission for not offering appointment letter to the petitioner in view of the panel published and in spite of vacancy.
