1. This revisional application has been filed with a prayer for quashing the proceeding in connection with G.R. Case No. 1009 of 2014 corresponding to Park Street Police Station Case No. 179 of 2014 under Section 30 of the Arms Act, 1959.
2. The proceeding was initiated in this case against the petitioner, who has licensed arms but he did not inform the authority at the time of shifting his residence.
3. However, at this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that he intends to withdraw the revisional application with liberty to agitate the issue before the Learned Trial Court at the time of consideration of charge.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State is also

present.

5. Heard both sides.
6. The revisional application stands dismissed being withdrawn.
7. Petitioner is at liberty to agitate all the issues before the Trial Court at the time of consideration of charge.
8. With the aforesaid observation, the revisional application stands disposed of.
