C.R.M. (A) 1859 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Ratua P.S. Case No.693 of 2024 dated 11.12.2024 under Sections 85/117(2)/118(1)/109/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioner no.1/husband of the de facto complainant has already been arrested.

Accordingly, the application is dismissed as infructuous so far as the petitioner no.1 is concerned.

Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the injury report, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. (A) 1859 of 2025** is, thus, rejected.
