In compliance with the order dated 10.09.2025, learned Advocate representing the State has placed the copy of the enquiry report submitted by the A.S.I. of Police, Ranaghat Police Station, RPD dated 28.10.2024 which had been placed before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia through the

G.R.O., Ranaghat Court. The said report taken on record, *inter alia*, stated as follows:-

"During enquiry I have gone through the contents petition and myself conducted a discreet enquiry into the instant matter in presence of few respectable inhabitants of the locality who were well acquainted with the fact and circumstances During enquiry of the incident, I meet the complainant to her house and asked for the paper of the general diary which she had filed with the Ranaghat Police Station, she refused to show it and it was learned from the local people that the complainant and the accused persons having a dispute over a village path for a long time. Based on that dispute, both parties filed several cases in Ld. Ranaghat court and Ranaghat police station, the complainant admitted in her complaint, currently the cases are under trial in the court. No evidence of any kind has been found regarding the incident mentioned by the complainant on 24.08.2024 between 9 AM to 11.30 AM. Petitioner received injury and treated Ranaghat S D Hospital. However, it is true that masonry work was going on in the houses of the accused persons. I presented to you what I found during the enquiry of the incident."

2. The petitioner denied to forward any document with regard to the complaint filed by her before the concerned Police Station relating to an incident which occurred between 9 AM to 11:30 AM on 24.08.2024. It was further submitted that the petitioner had received injuries. The injury report mentioned about physical assault without any cut injury and pain on right side of the face just below the right eye and the chest pain. However, the injury report did not mention the name of the persons who had assaulted the petitioner.

3. The learned ACJM, Ranaghat, Nadia vide order dated 07.03.2025 had rightly dismissed the application under Section 175(3) of the BNSS filed by the complainant/petitioner herein. The parties are involved in dispute over a village path for a long time giving rise of multiple number of cases pending before the respective Courts. The instant complaint devoid of merits had been rightly dismissed by the A.C.J.M., Ranaghat, Nadia.
4. Accordingly, the instant revisional application being CRR No.2409 of 2025 is disposed of.
