- 1) Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
- 2) During course of hearing it has been pointed by the learned advocate representing the State respondents that though as per relevant rules relating to transfer, in the event applicant teacher is an Assistant Teacher, Head of the Institution is required to put signature in the prescribed *pro-forma* granting 'No Objection' but in the present case, surprisingly President of the Managing Committee of the school where petitioner is presently working has signed on 6th May, 2025.
