This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the wife praying for a direction upon the learned Additional District Judge, 14th Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas to dispose of the Matrimonial Suit No. 414 of 2025 expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to issue notice upon the opposite party. However, the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite party or upon the learned advocates representing them before the learned trial judge.

From the order-sheets appended to the revisional application this Court finds that 2nd July, 2025 has been fixed for hearing the petition on 15th May, 2025.
