Case No.443 of 2023 dated 18.06.2023 under Sections 341/353/332/333/188/186/224/323/206/ 34 of the IPC and Under Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Under Section 9 of MPO Act.

Considering the nature of allegations, the incriminating materials available in the case diary and the fact that the prayer for anticipatory bail of a similarly circumstanced co-accused was turned down on 24.12.2024 by a Division Bench of this Court in CRM(A) 4627 of 2024, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
