This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the respondent praying for a direction upon the learned Additional District Judge Fast Track, 3rd Court at Barrackpore to dispose of Title Appeal No.22 of 2023 expeditiously.

Mr. Ghose, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the appeal is otherwise ready for hearing and July 29, 2025 has been fixed for hearing of the title appeal.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite party. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite party or the learned advocates representing the opposite party before the learned trial judge.

In the light of the submission made by the learned advocate for the petitioner, CO 1824 of 2024 stands disposed of by requesting the learned Additional District Judge Fast Track, 3rd Court at Barrackpore to take up

the hearing of the Title Appeal No.22 of 2023 on the next date fixed i.e. on July 29, 2025, if the same is otherwise ready for hearing, and to make an endeavour to dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible but preferably within a period of 6 months from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

There will be no order as to costs.
