CRM (A) 1950 of 2025

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with English Bazar P.S. Case No.912 of 2024 dated 08.07.2024 under Sections 448/323/376/511/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Malda.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the materials available in the case diary and the fact that the statements of witnesses referred to a prior land dispute, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition he shall meet the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall

not threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

The application for anticipatory bail being **CRM (A) 1950 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
