In spite of service, none appears on behalf
of the State-respondents.

The petitioner was a librarian of a Library
under the Department of Mass Education
Extension & Library Services. On attaining the
age of superannuation he had retired from his
said service on November 30, 2016.

The Pension Payment Order of the
petitioner was issued on June 23, 2017 but he
had received the gratuity and the arrear pension
on August 01, 2017.

The petitioner is praying interest on the
arrear pension and gratuity for the delayed
payment.

The pension and gratuity have been paid to
the petitioner within a reasonable time after
retirement, therefore, the prayer of the petitioner

for interest on the said pension and gratuity amount cannot be entertained.

W.P.A. 12936 of 2025 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
