An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Karimpur P.S. Case No.54 of 2025 dated 02.04.2025 under Sections 329(3)/117(2)/118(2)/109/3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

Heard learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the fact that there are case and counter case and both sides suffered injuries and in view of the fact that the charge-sheet has been submitted, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure,

1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on the further conditions that the petitioner shall stay outside of jurisdiction of Karimpur Police Station for a period of six months except for attending the jurisdictional court or meeting the investigating officer and shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
