This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the defendants praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), 1st Court at Barasat in Title Suit No. 1047 of 2023 expeditiously.

From the order-sheets appended to this application this court finds that an application under Order 7 Rule 11 of the Civil Procedure Code is still pending.
