Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the nature of allegations and the materials available in the case diary, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with investigation and shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight till submission of report in final form and shall not

threaten or intimidate witnesses and the petitioner shall stay outside the jurisdiction of Chhatna Police Station for a period of four months except for meeting the I.O. or attending the jurisdictional Court.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
