It is made clear that, this Court has not gone into the merits of the matter at all and all points are kept open for the parties to urge before the jurisdictional tribunal.

It is expected that, no unnecessary adjournment should be granted to the parties.

On the above terms this writ petition **W.P.A. 13057 of 2025** stands **disposed of**, without any order as to costs.
