Learned advocate for the petitioners
submits that inspite of the civil court
having passed directions, the police
authorities have refused to act on the
same.

State has submitted a report
which reflects that number of criminal

their surveillance as also ensure that no
breach of the peace and/or tranquility
takes place.

WPA 13687 of 2025 is disposed of.
