Learned advocates for the
petitioners, private respondents and the
State are present.

The petitioners are aggrieved by
the fact that their peaceful possession is
being disturbed and the household articles
are ransacked. It is also alleged by the
petitioners that a large portion of the
house was demolished.

An information, to that effect, was
furnished on 18th of May, 2023 with the

Officer-in-charge of Kultali Police Station.

In view of the time period which has passed in the meantime (more than one and half years), I direct the Officer-in-charge of Kultali police station to forward such information to the Superintendent of Police of the concerned district. The Superintendent of Police will enquire into the information within a period of four weeks and inform the steps and/or decision taken by him/her, within a fortnight, thereafter.

In case, the complaint dated 18.05.2023 is missing, the Officer-in-charge of Kultali P.S. will issue a notice for supply of such copy to the petitioners, who would hand over the same, thereafter, the officer-in-charge will act in terms of the directions passed above.

With the aforesaid observations,

WPA 13734 of 2023 is disposed of.
