This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the owner of a vehicle and is directed against an order being No. 31 dated 16th June, 2025 passed by the learned Judge, Motor Accident Claim Tribunal in M.A.C. Case (Ex). 02 of 2021.

By the order impugned the application filed by the petitioner praying for release of the vehicle is fixed on 25th June, 2025.
