This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the defendant No.1/counter-claimant praying for a direction upon the learned Judge, 7th Bench, City Civil Court at Calcutta to dispose of Title Suit No.3246 of 2007 expeditiously.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite party. However, the learned advocate for the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with this order upon the opposite party or the learned advocates representing the opposite party before the learned trial judge.

There will be no order as to costs.
