Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate for the petitioner be kept with the record.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved Assistant Teacher of a Primary School and retired from his said service on superannuation on August 31, 1991 and died on February 07, 2019.

The Pension Payment Order of the employee concerned was issued on January 31, 2002 in pursuance whereof the petitioner received the gratuity and arrear family pension on April 30, 2002.

In the instant writ petition the prayer of the petitioner is a writ of mandamus be issued commanding the respondents to pay interest on

the said amount of arrear family pension and gratuity for the delayed payment.

Learned advocate for the State-respondents does not oppose of the prayer of the petitioner.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay interest @ 8% per annum on the arrear amount of family pension and gratuity from the date of retirement of the employee concerned till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default, the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A. 15127 of 2024 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
