In case, within a week, the petitioner do not get smooth access with regard to her free egress and ingress, in that case, the police authorities and/or the petitioner will approach the concerned Magistrate who is *in seisin* of Mahishadal PS Case No. 08 of 2025 dated

05.01.2025. The learned Magistrate would after calling for a report from the police authorities direct the accused persons of the case not to enter the jurisdiction of Mahishadal P.S. till further orders passed by the learned Magistrate.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 13951 of 2025 is disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
