3. A legal representation on behalf of the petitioner is pending consideration at the end of the Vice Chancellor, Raiganj University.
4. Without entering into the merit of the claim of the petitioner, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing Vice Chancellor, Raiganj University to take into consideration the legal representation filed on behalf of the petitioner in accordance with the law after giving a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and all other necessary parties and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order at the earliest but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.
