Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State files copies of questionnaire that was sent by E-mail to the petitioner, but he did not respond to in spite of a direction passed in this regard earlier and despite of an interim order granted.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the de facto complainant submits that an amount of Rs. 34 crores was collected from the market by way of an IPO, but no balance-sheet was filed. After collecting the money, the petitioner and other co-accused simply disappeared from the scene.

No one appears on behalf of the petitioner.

No accommodation is sought.

On the earlier occasion i.e., on 28.10.2025, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner or prayed for any adjournment.

In view of the above, the application is dismissed for default.

Interim order, if any, shall stand vacated.
