The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that she has been deceived by the private respondents and, inspite of informing the police authorities on or about 31.03.2024, no steps have been taken

As the petitioner is a senior citizen, she is unable to pursue the remedies.

State has submitted a report which do not reflect that any case was registered, rather, the information which was furnished was reduced to General

Diary Entry.

Having considered that the police authorities did not take any step, I direct the petitioner to approach the jurisdictional Magistrate under Section 175(3) of the BNSS. The learned Magistrate would assess whether the petitioner has been deceived and, thereafter, pass necessary directions as he/she deems fit and proper.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 15388 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
