1. The petitioner renews his prayer for bail which was last rejected *vide* order dated 11<sup>th</sup> of April, 2025, passed in CRM (DB) 957 of 2025. His earlier bail prayers were also rejected.
2. The grievance of the learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner is that the trial is no progressing.
3. Learned Counsel for the State submits that only two witnesses are left to be examined and the next date fixed before the learned Trial Court is 15<sup>th</sup> of July, 2025.
4. The State is directed to produce both the witnesses on 15<sup>th</sup> of July, 2025. The learned Trial Court is requested to conclude the testimony of the prosecution witnesses on 15<sup>th</sup> of July, 2025 or on the next date fixed by the Court.
5. The Court finds that there is no change of circumstances entitling the petitioner to be admitted to bail.

6. The application being CRM(M)/899/2025 is accordingly dismissed.
7. Memo of Evidence be kept with the records.
